In order to insure the continued non-technical breadth formerly provided by the “Humanities and Social Science Requirements” in the College’s curricula, the College is imposing one set of mild constraints on the Gen Ed Breadth of Knowledge (BoK) requirements (Rule II below). The revised Gen Ed rules for Engineering majors will thus read as follows.

I. The University’s General Education requirements must be met, specifically including the taking of 8 courses in a minimum of 5 of the 6 BoK distribution areas.

II. In so doing, a minimum of 24 credit hours of Gen Ed BoK courses, including 6 credit hours from a subset of the University’s Gen Ed lists defined by the College of Engineering as “upper level”, must be taken from the following areas:

- a.) The Five BoK Distribution Areas other than Natural Sciences
- b.) Diversity & Culture
- c.) Social & Ethical Issues

Please note that Rule II allows, but does not require, the use of courses from (b) and (c) in the 24 credit hours.

III. No requirements specified on the Curriculum Check Sheet are allowed to be counted in the 24 credit hours of Gen Ed BoK courses unless so indicated on the sheet.

Note: Parallel courses may not be counted twice, e.g. 15 GRMN 101 and 30 GRMN 101 may not both be used.

In order to insure the continued non-technical breadth formerly provided by the “Humanities and Social Science Requirements” in the College’s curricula, the College is imposing one set of mild constraints on the Gen Ed Breadth of Knowledge (BoK) requirements (Rule II below). The revised Gen Ed rules for Computer Science majors will thus read as follows.

I. The University’s General Education requirements must be met, specifically including the taking of 8 courses in a minimum of 5 of the 6 BoK distribution areas.

II. In so doing, a minimum of 45 credit hours of Gen Ed BoK courses, including 12 credit hours from a subset of the University’s Gen Ed lists defined by the College of Engineering as “upper level”, must be taken from the following areas:

- a.) The Five BoK Distribution Areas other than Natural Sciences
- b.) Diversity & Culture
- c.) Social & Ethical Issues

Please note that Rule II allows, but does not require, the use of courses from (b) and (c) in the 45 credit hours.

III. No requirements specified on the Curriculum Check Sheet are allowed to be counted in the 45 credit hours of Gen Ed BoK courses unless so indicated on the sheet.

Note: Parallel courses may not be counted twice, e.g. 15 GRMN 101 and 30 GRMN 101 may not both be used.
