## Simple vi editing Commands

Opening a file vi file\_spec (for new or existing files)

**Exiting a file with save** :wq (or ZZ)

**Exiting a file without save** :q (if no changes were made)

:q! (if the file was changed)

**Two basic modes** command mode (entered with an <esc>)

insert mode

**Insert mode** i (for insert)

a (for append)o (for open)

**Cursor Movement** h – left

 $\begin{array}{l} j-down \\ k-up \end{array}$ 

1 - right (or use the spacebar)

\$ - end of line

0 – beginning of line G – bottom of document

:1 - top of document (that's the number one)

**Deleting text** x – deletes a character

dw – deletes a word dd – deletes a line

nx, ndw, ndd - deletes n chars, words or lines respectively

Cut and Paste ndd - will cut n lines and place in buffer

nyy – will copy n lines and place in buffer p – will put buffer where the cursor is placed

**Miscellaneous** / string – searches and moves to first occurrence of string

. – redo last commandu – undo last command

r - replace one character (overwrite)
