

Input Dialog Example (with Cancel and OK)

private void btnInputDialogActionPerformed(java.awt.event.ActionEvent evt) {  
  
    String input;  
  
    input = JOptionPane.showInputDialog(this, "Enter some stuff:", "InputDialog",  
        JOptionPane.PLAIN_MESSAGE);  
  
    if (input == null) {  
        // first output statement is an error – why?  
        //txtOutput.setText("You clicked cancel - string length: " + input.length());  
        txtOutput.setText("You clicked cancel - string length: 0 (null)");  
    }  
    else if (input.length() == 0)  
        txtOutput.setText("You clicked ok - string length: " + input.length());  
    else  
        txtOutput.setText(input + " - string length: " + input.length());
